

Upgrading to Windows 10 Education

Option 1: Windows 10 Update

- The Update Assistant can help you update to the latest version of Windows 10.
- Windows 10 Home/Professional users:
 - Go to **Settings** » **Update and security** » **Activation**, and click: **Change product key**.
 - Enter the product key from your Order Details page to upgrade to Windows 10 Education.

Option 2: Create Windows 10 Installation Media

- This option is recommended for systems running Windows 8.1, or 7, or if you need to reinstall Windows 10 on a PC on which Windows 10 has already been successfully activated.
- A blank USB/DVD disc with at least 8GB is required to create a bootable disc. Note: any content on the USB/DVD will be deleted during installation.

Option 3: Download Windows 10 Disk Image (ISO)

- This option creates a bootable installation media or virtual machine (.ISO file) to install Windows 10 on a different PC, on a PC running Windows XP or Vista, or on a Mac computer.
- A blank USB/DVD disc with at least 8GB is required to create a bootable disc. Note: any content on the USB/DVD will be deleted during installation.
